

2023 Jersey Rally Entries

Forty years of the Jersey Rally is celebrated in 2023 although the first "rally" in Jersey was in December 1935!

That event had 12 driving tests which the local paper advised "motorists with only 1 or 2 years' experience should pass with little difficulty". The Connetable of St Brelade donated a trophy won by D Woods in a mighty 10bhp Ford. Fast forward to 2023 and the winning car is likely to be over 300bhp! Move on to 1977 and you find the modern heritage of the Jersey Rally - the Daffodil Rally and the Spring Festival Rally closing Island roads for the first time for competitive stages. Unfortunately a law officer believed these were scavenger hunts and he felt the 1946 Road Racing Law should not be used - it was to be 5 years before closed road rallying returned to the Island!

However everyone likes a challenge and a dedicated team persuaded the authorities in 1983 that the law was relevant to rallying against the clock and the Jersey Rally on closed public roads was borne. Thanks to those initial enthusiasts – John Woolley, Denis Jean, Pat Ryan, Ken Thomson and Brian Wilson – the first event took place on 29 October 1983 with 32 cars crossing the start line. Tony Morgan and Roger Evans (2.3 ltr Chevette) were the first winners, travelling from Walesto victory. Look out for the replica appearing in the 2023 Roberts Garages Jersey Rally! A third of the entry came over from the UK - no Guernsey entrants at that stage, with Ford Escort being the most popular car.

Launching the rally was as "straightforward" as the country lanes! A lot of folk did not understand the concept and wondered how cars would overtake as on a circuit. There were many parish and official meetings. The team were delighted that the vast majority of initial critics were persuaded to support the concept – even more so after 1984 when rally representatives began to visit all the households to explain what was planned – a key feature which continues today – some 1,800 households and land being visited this year!

The two day format, with Friday including night stages, began in the mid-90's, and it has been supported by a number of loyal predominantly local sponsors over the years. It is widely regarded as a challenging rally – even compared to events at world rally level – and attracts many visitors each year keen to pitch their driving skills against the local Jersey drivers and codrivers. The initial years were sponsored by Tudor Webasto Sunroofs, thanks to local Pat Ryan a works driver for British Leyland whose family owned Cleveland Garages. Long term supporters have included Paperclix and now Roberts Garages.

The Jersey Rally has also seen increased interest from the UK and from France – with some 30 teams from England, Wales and Scotland and 16 teams from Guernsey.

As the scale of the event has grown so have the number of entries. 2023 will witness 180 crews of driver and co-driver, plus support crew, well over 300 marshals and 100 or so officials – all volunteers contributing their time and expertise to a major motorsport event. The Jersey Rally has also seen increased interest from the UK and from France – with some 30 teams from England, Wales and Scotland and 16 teams from Guernsey.

There has always been keen interest from the UK which has seen 16 outright winners in cars as diverse as the Vauxhall Chevette, Ford Escort, MG Metro 6R4, Mitsubishi Lancer and Evo, Subaru world rally cars, Peugeot Maxi and Fiesta "R5". In fact overseas visitors have won on 18 occasions including 2 wins for Welsh enthusiasts. We have yet to see a win from Guernsey but it's only a matter of time. Simon Mauger and Brian Cammack from Oxfordshire achieved the most wins (6) from 2007 onwards. Local driver Dave Carrel achieved 5 wins, partnered by Peter Collinson, then his wife, Julie, and then Peter Mallett. In the rankings, in a range of powerful modern Escorts, both Chris Le Bonniec with Richard Hollick and Steve Hendy (Hendy Ford UK) have managed 4 wins a piece.

One of the stand out performances was Stuart and Theresa Fossey who, in 2005, won the Jersey Rally outright in a Talbot Sunbeam – the only 1600 cc to achieve this and a giant beating achievement. The first FWD victory fell to Chris West and Robbie Hannah in the Peugeot Maxi in 2019. Amongst the champions rallying in the 2023 Jersey Rally will be several former winners including Jeremy Baudains (1992), Stevie Leonard and Sion Humphreys (2013,2015, 2017), Tony Morgan (1983). Ross Le Noa and Domonic Volante (2018 & 2021), will be seeking another historic "triple crown" again of Guernsey, L'Etacq and Jersey but will face stiff competition.

Away from the victors, some spectacular drivers have been attracted to the Island over the 40 years including Jersey's adopted F1 driver Derek Warwick (1994), former Le Mans and endurance champion, Derek Bell (1995), British rallying legend, Tony Pond, British rally champion – Jimmy McRae, father of Colin McRae, National ladies' champion Barbara Armstrong and TV presenter Louise Goodman. Welsh team of Peter Llloyd with Colin McRae's codriver, Nicky Grist, took the Island by storm in 2009 to win the event. Grist stated that the Jersey Rally was as tough as any world rally championship event but with more fun!

The Jersey Rally has always been focussed on supporting the Island community, whether by charity fundraising and exposure, visits to schools or community initiatives. In the early years, significant funds were raised for Family Nursing and Homecare – the 1995 event paid for key equipment and monies were raised in many years for this worthy cause. Individual teams are all supported in profiling the charities they support, many of which are personal to the team. In 2011 the first of a number of environmental measures was launched - with the move to centralised Rally HQ and service reducing fuel consumption considerably for all officials and service crews. The transition to electronic documentation has made a significant difference in recent years. In 2012 the Jersey Rally supported the national charity, Project Mobility, for injured servicemen. A team of Landrovers competed in the event, not everyone's initial car choice for closed road rallying, but worthy competitors raising the profile of this charity.
