understanding as the rally comes to their doorsteps. Your support is invaluable, and we are deeply grateful.


We also applaud the organisers, marshals, and volunteers whose tireless work ensures the safety and success of the rally, and we commend the competitors who test their limits on the course.











Stages 7, 9 & 11 - St Brelade - Friday Evening




Stages 8, 10 & 12 - Rossignol - Friday Evening







Stages 13, 15 & 17 - Frontiere - Saturday am






Stages 14, 16 & 18 - Waterworks - Saturday am






Stages 19, 21 & 23 - Lawrence - Saturday pm


